WELCOME TO RIDE AND RALLY 2023



Thank you for joining us for our State ATV Convention, Ride and Rally 2023. This year the convention is being hosted by the Rangers Snowmobile and ATV club along with the Quad Cities ATV club. These two clubs have been very busy over the last several years, improving their existing trail system and making some very important additions. They continue to work additional connection that will allow ATV trail access north out of Virginia and an off-road trail heading east out of Hoyt Lakes.

During the Presidents Ride on Friday, we will see the extensive boardwalk that was completed this year that finally connects the Ranger ATV Trail system to the Iron Range OHV State Recreation Area and continuing into Eveleth and Virginia, connecting with the Quad Cities ATV trail system. This ride will also take us over the Tom Rukavina Memorial bridge, the highest bridge in Minnesota, and one the clubs worked closely with Minnesota Department of Transportation and the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources to ensure they had a lane for ATV and snowmobile traffic included on the bridge.

These are great examples of funding coming from many different sources that have come together to complete an important connection between towns and continue an important trail system. What has been accomplished by these different agencies and trail groups working together is extremely impressive. A great example of what can be done by working together.

For Saturday, the host clubs have arranged for eleven different guided rides. These rides go to different destinations, vary in length and leave at different times. So please review the options and sign up for the one that best suits your interests. You also have the option to ride on your own and explore the trail systems that are available to you in this area.

All rides are scheduled to be back by 4:00 p.m. on Saturday afternoon because social hour, silent auction and other events start at Giants Ridge Lodge at 5:00 p.m. Our banquet will start serving around 6:00 with the General Membership meeting to follow. Membership meeting will consist of an update from our Lobbyist, election of our Treasure and 1st Vice President, words from any major sponsors or dignitaries in attendance, and any other general membership issues that need to be covered.

The General Membership meeting will be followed by the live auction, back again this year by popular demand. This event is the main fundraiser for the State Association for the year. This allows us to keep a lobbyist working for the interests of all ATV riders in the state. Also allows us to keep a person in the office to answer questions and send out information and stay on top of memberships, especially as the State Association takes over memberships for several of the clubs as well as Association memberships. These funds are also used to keep our communications flowing to our members. Our State Communications Director is in a paid half-time position doing full-time work producing our newsletter twice per month and our magazine six times per year. None of the executive board nor the regional directors receive any compensation for time or travel. That certainly isn't how we want to continue operating but with the current budget it is our only option.

Sunday morning, we will be holding the State Board meeting at Giants Ridge Lodge starting at 9:00 a.m. All are welcome and we strive to be done before noon. According to our by-laws we must hold two in-person meetings, this is one of them, so we will **not** be providing a Zoom option for this meeting.

Again, thank you for joining us at this year's state convention, Ride and Rally 2023. The host clubs have put a lot of time and energy into pulling together a great convention. Please take the time to thank them as you see them throughout the weekend. As any club that has sponsored this event in the past knows, it takes a lot of work to make it a success.

RANGER SNOWMOBILE/ATV CLUB AND QUAD CITIES ATV CLUB HOST STATE ATV CONVENTION

The 2023 ATV MN Ride & Rally State Convention is an annual event for ATV enthusiasts to come together, celebrate accomplishments, ride some of the best trails in the region, and enjoy a weekend full of fun and excitement. The event is open to riders of all skill levels. The Ranger Snowmobile/ATV Club and the Quad Cities ATV Club are excited to be co-hosting the convention this year at The Lodge, Giants Ridge Recreation Area in Biwabik. The Lodge at Giants Ridge is a beautiful resort that offers stunning views of the Minnesota wilderness. ATV enthusiasts from all over the state have registered for this exciting convention, which will offer guided ATV rides, vendor exhibits, and a banquet.

On Friday, September 22, the convention will kick off with the ATV MN President's ride. The ride will start from Giants Ridge and will travel to the Iron Trail Convention Center in Virginia, MN. This ride will traverse the new $\frac{3}{4}$ mile long 16' wide boardwalk and then across the Thomas Rukavina Memorial Bridge. At 204 ft (62m) it is the tallest bridge in Minnesota spanning the Rouchleau mine pit. Once at the Iron trail Convention Center there will be a welcome reception and a provided lunch for all attendees. Of note, the ride will include local and state dignitaries and is a great opportunity for participants to meet and ride with some of the most influential people in Minnesota's ATV community.

On Saturday, September 23, the clubs will offer 11 different guided ATV trail rides scheduled throughout the day. The rides will take participants through some of the most beautiful and scenic areas of the eastern Iron

Range. There will be multiple ride options available, so riders of all skill levels can participate. Rides will vary in distance between 25 miles up to 100 miles, so riders can choose one that matches their ability and riding interests.

Vendor and sponsor exhibits will also be open on Saturday and will feature the latest ATV accessories, gear, and equipment. Attendees will have the opportunity to meet with vendors and check out the latest products on the market.

The clubs will be hosting a banquet followed by a brief ATV MN membership meeting before launching into both live and silent auctions. Participants will have the chance to relax and socialize with other ATV enthusiasts while enjoying a great meal.

The 2023 ATV MN Ride & Rally State Convention coming to the Iron Range is more than just a gathering of ATV enthusiasts enjoying its scenic beauty; it's also a testament to the significant investments made in trail development on the Iron Range. The collaboration between the Quad Cities ATV Club and the Ranger Snowmobile/ATV Club has resulted in over \$3.3 million of funding in the last few years alone. These investments have fueled numerous trail development projects, including the $\frac{3}{4}$ mile boardwalk trail linking Gilbert to Biwabik, a new bridge east of Hoyt Lakes, as well as numerous culvert constructions, brushing and graveling for ongoing maintenance of existing trails.

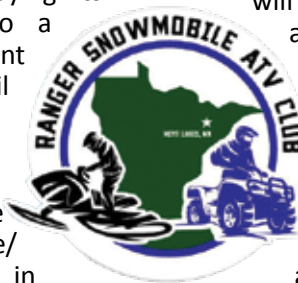
These two clubs are not working in isolation, but are part of a broader

effort to promote outdoor recreation in Northern Minnesota. Specifically, they are part of the Northeastern Regional ATV Joint Powers Board that includes representatives from St Louis, Koochiching and Lake Counties as well as thirteen other ATV clubs throughout Northern Minnesota. The Joint Powers Board was created with the goal of developing both short and long-term plans for outdoor recreation in the region. This includes identifying new trail systems, improving existing trails. All of this in an effort to ensure that when trail projects are funded, they will be completed on time and in an environmentally sustainable manner.

Currently the Rangers Snowmobile/ATV Club is working with the Prospectors Trail Alliance (Ely) on two of the "Connect Four" newly proposed ATV trail segments, and a connecting spur. This is part of phase 2 of the greater Prospectors Loop Trail for off-highway vehicles. Approximately 59 miles of trail are included: 22 miles of existing route open to ATV use, and 9 miles of proposed new route for ATV use. This will help formulate connecting access to larger trail systems and local communities.

The Quad Cities ATV Club is also working with the Joint Powers Board, federal, state, and local agencies to provide greater access for off-highway vehicles to and from local communities. After several years of planning and hard work behind the scenes securing permitting, the Quad Cities ATV Club is very pleased to announce that our new connecting trail between Pfeiffer Lake and St. Louis County Road 361 is nearing completion. This trail has been a coordinated effort

between the Quad Cities ATV Club,

the DNR, and the USFS. This trail establishes an important connection from the Big Aspen trail system/Forest Road 256 in Britt (north of Virginia) to the Cook area and beyond, and is one more step towards connecting the Iron Range communities to the Voyageur Country and Ely area trail systems. The route is roughly 5 miles, and follows a combination of existing logging roads, snowmobile trails, and some newly created trail sections in order to cross MN State Highway 1 and connect to St. Louis County Highway 361, which will connect to the northern trail systems via other county roads and existing trail sections. The trail begins on the Pfeiffer Lake Campground Road, connects to the Taconite Snowmobile Trail, and then branches northward through the forest eventually crossing Highway 1 and linking to County Road 361 via a short frontage trail along Highway 1.

These trail development efforts not only underscore the dedication of the clubs to the sport but also emphasize the positive economic impact of outdoor recreation on local communities. The Iron Range's popularity among ATV enthusiasts, coupled with the continued investments in trail infrastructure, ensures its position as a premier ATV destination. Through collaboration and dedication, the Quad Cities ATV Club and the Ranger Snowmobile/ATV Club are leaving an indelible mark on the area's trail system, benefitting riders, businesses, and the broader community for years to come.

But their impact extends far beyond the trails. The Ride & Rally State ATV Convention is a driving force in boosting the local and state economy. The Iron Range community is set to reap the rewards of the influx of visitors and participants. Restaurants, accommodations, and shops all benefit in a positive ripple effect that extends throughout the community. The University of Minnesota Extension's collaboration with the Northeastern Joint Powers Board reflects a shared commitment to understanding and maximizing the economic potential of ATVing. By



conducting a comprehensive survey and developing an economic impact study, the organizations are working hand in hand to shed light on the tangible benefits that ATV riders and events like the Ride & Rally can bring to communities.

While the data analysis is ongoing, the initial insights do paint an encouraging picture of the economic windfall that ATV riders and their events have the potential to deliver. As we eagerly await the U of MN Extension's finalized economic impact study. It is evident that the 2023 Ride & Rally ATV Event is not only a celebration of the sport but also a catalyst for economic growth in the local area.

In the case of the Ride & Rally event the economic boost is undoubtedly driven by its sponsors. Sponsors from across the Range have stepped up to help the local clubs create a convention experience that will not only resonate throughout the ATV community, but will enhance the area economically. Their unwavering support ensures that ATVing remains a recreational opportunity accessible to all who visit the area. This year's

convention is all about showcasing the responsible and respectful nature of ATV enthusiasts, emphasizing the importance of providing safety training programs for youth, adhering to rules, and respecting the environment.
